REFLECTION: SEASON OF CREATION – POPE FRANCIS

How can we contribute to the mighty river of justice and peace in this Season of Creation? What can we, particularly as Christian communities do to heal our common home so that it can once again team with life? We must do this by resolving to transform our hearts, our lifestyles and the public policies ruling our societies. First let us join the mighty river by transforming our hearts. This is essential for any other transformation to occur; it is that ecological conversation" which Saint John Paull II encouraged us to embrace: the renewal of our relationship with creation so that we no longer see it as an object to be exploited but cherish it instead as a sacred gift from our creator. Furthermore, we should realise that an integral approach to respect for the environment involves four relationships: with God, with our brothers and sisters of today and tomorrow, with all of nature and with ourselves.

PRAY FOR VOCATIONS

Last week we celebrated the feast of the TRIUMPH OF THE CROSS. The great sacrifice of Christ: God so loved the world that he gave his only son. To be a self-sacrificing person is implicit in our Baptism, as we strive to follow Christ and imitate his ways. The self-giving of Christ invites each of us to the same call. The insistence of that call, and it's constant tugging of our hearts, is what tends to nudge people to their vocation. We long to love whole heartedly, and we know the truth that – 'It is in giving that we receive". "I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worth comparing with the glory about to be revealed to us. We know that all things work together for good for those who love God". (Romans 8.)
