## **LENTEN FUNDRAISING PROJECT 2023**

Thank you, once again, to all those who submitted proposals for our Lenten project for this year. After careful consideration of them all, the PPC has chosen **ECOLE DON BOSCO**, **IN HADATH BAALBECK IN LEBANON**, run by Salesian Sisters. This school was opened in 1974 and is a centre for 1,200 children and young adults coming from 15 villages in the surrounding area. The small community works for the benefit of these schoolchildren, mostly coming from non-affluent families. In these extremely hard times for Lebanon, the school suffers from a dire shortage of necessary provisions that are vitally important for a good education and standard of living.

Ash Wednesday is on 22 February and Lent begins on Sunday 26 March. This gives time for individuals and small groups to formulate ideas and plans for fundraising. Information on the school and current dates for your diary, are available in the leaflet which is being distributed after all Masses this Sunday and copies will be available in the Church and on our parish website. If you are able to **organise and do** something, please submit your proposal to the parish office as soon as possible.
