REFLECTION

Christ told his followers that they should not be afraid to declare themselves for him before other people. Are we sometimes afraid to speak and to act in a Christian way? If so why is this? It is because we are unwilling to suffer for Christ or is it simply that we are afraid of what others will say? We cannot witness to Christ without his grace. Saint John Henry Newman once asked his congregation to ponder on what Christ meant to them, and what difference being a Christian made in the way they lived their daily lives. He asked: "Is it the case that there is nothing we resolve, nothing we do or not do, nothing we avoid or choose, nothing we give up or take up which we would not resolve, or do, or omit, or avoid, or chose, or give up if Christ had not died and if heaven were not promised to us?" "I really fear" he went on "that most of those who call themselves Christians would go on almost as they do if they believed Christianity to be nothing more than a fable".
