JUBILEE REFLECTION - SEA SUNDAY

In this Jubilee Year, we are invited to be *Pilgrims of* Hope - people who bring light into dark places and show mercy in action. That is exactly what our support of Stella Maris (Apostleship of the Sea) does. It brings hope to those who feel forgotten. It reminds them they are not alone. Over the past year, Stella Maris supported more than 100,000 seafarers in UK ports, and many more worldwide. But the need is growing because more crews are being abandoned, and many seafarers still aren't allowed shore leave. Mental health is worsening.
