REFLECTION

Today's gospel talks about some people who refused an invitation to a wedding feast, and others who accepted it. We are here because God in his love has invited us, and we have accepted his invitation. But we presume love is not enough. Very important is the Spirit in which we come. We should come in a spirit of thankfulness and joy. Today is a banquet of truth and goodness, a banquet of holiness and grace, a banquet of justice, love and peace. Vincent van Gogh once wrote "My only anxiety is how I can be of use in the world. But one feels a terrible discouragement, one feels an emptiness where there might be friendships, and one exclaims: "How long God?" There may be a great fire in our souls, but no one ever comes to warm himself beside it, and the passerby sees only a wisp of smoke coming through the chimney and pass on their way. So, what must one do? We must go on tending the inner fire and wait patiently for the hour when somebody will come and sit down near it to stay there maybe. Let those who believe in God wait for that hour, for it will come sooner or later".

God who calls us all to contribute to this Kingdom, take our insecurities and vulnerability and weave them through with your holy confidence which always reassures us that we have something to offer. As we explore what you are asking of us, we pray for integrity of heart, clarity of mind and yearning to love and serve others wherever that may take us.
